According the WCC Institutional Survey distributed to the campus community in Spring 2023, 97% of students indicated that WCC has an excellent or satisfactory learning environment.




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33 students responded to the WCC Institutional Survey distributed to the campus in Spring 2023.

76% of respondents noted that WCC was their primary campus, 57% stated that they were full-time students, and the largest group of identified respondents were enrolled only in online courses.








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WCC Mission Statement


Graduated from the Ka'ohekani program and continue to take Hawaiian music classes

They provide well educational support that's easily accessible to all students.



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Facilities and Equipment ordered by excellent and satisfactory responses




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Comments:


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Comments:

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
Comments:



Food services and other buildings are closed Fridays when we're in class as well as other bathrooms. That is not good. Please reopen the cafeteria. We need food as students.


