The Certificate in Achievement (CA): Foundation in Acting is a workforce preparation program for performers intending to pursue a career in the entertainment industry as an actor on stage or screen. Foundation in Acting mirrors similar certificates of higher education, commonly called Foundation Year programs, found in conservatories and premiere drama schools.
